# **CEWRI-MIT** SUBPROGRAMS



Provides funding for the installation of PVS and BSS for **LMI Households** owners and occupants of a singlefamily structure as primary residence. Provides funding for the installation of PVS and BSS for **non-LMI Households** owners and occupants a single-family structure as primary residence. Provides funding to **identified communities** to install energy production and storage, water capture systems, and solutions for sanitary sewer systems.



### Photovoltaic System Requirements

3kW Min. Capacity

Max. Capacity Based on Annual Energy Consumption for Award Calculation

PV Panels to be installed in roof

# Battery Storage System

### Requirements

9kWh Min. Capacity

20kWh Max. Capacity for Award Calculation

Lithium-ion Chemistry



### Permanent Affixion

System must be permanently affixed to the structure and not show signs of portability



### **Project Start**

Installation cannot begin until an award for the System is executed between the Applicant and PRDOH



# **SYSTEM** *ELIGIBILITY*



### System Design & Permitting

Design must be performed by a licensed engineer

Design must be consistent with existing site conditions



### Equipment

Equipment must be new

Equipment must be duly certified under Regulation 7796

Inverters are required to comply with the grid support and communication characteristics in IEEE 1547



### Installation

Installation through a Program-approved REIC

Installation by a certified Installer

System must be commissioned following the requirements of IEC 62446



### Interconnection With Power Grid

All systems must submit an Interconnection Request to the Power Utility



### Warranties

10 years min. for PV Panels

25 years min. of Linear Performance Guarantee for Photovoltaic Modules

10 years min. for battery banks and inverters

# **PROMINENT REVIEW FACTORS**



# Historic Preservation

Required for Properties that are 45 years old, located in traditional urban centers or listed in the National Register of Historic Places





# Floodplain Management

Required for Properties located in a Special Flood Hazard Area (100-year floodplain)

# Substantial Improvements

Floodplain houses that require appraisals to confirm that improvement does not exceed 50% of the home value

# Lead-Based Paint Requirements

For Properties built before 1978 requiring some paint disturbance; less than 20 sq.ft for the exterior and less than 6 sq.ft. for any interior room


